



Some Postdoctoral Funding Opportunities

Recommended by the Office of Graduate Fellowships & Awards

- **National Institute of Health (NIH) F32**
 - Ruth L. Kirschstein National Research Service Award (NRSA) Individual Postdoctoral Fellowship, To enhance the research training of promising postdoctoral candidates who have the potential to become productive, independent investigators in scientific health-related research fields relevant to the missions of the participating NIH Institutes and Centers; Award Includes: Stipend and institutional allowance, <http://grants.nih.gov/grants/guide/pa-files/PA-14-149.html>
- **L'Oréal USA Fellowships for Women in Science**
 - Supports U.S.-based women researchers in science, technology, engineering, and math fields during their postdoctoral research; Award Amount: Up to \$60,000; must be put towards postdoctoral research, <http://www.aaas.org/page/l-or-al-usa-fellowships-women-science>
- **AFTD Postdoctoral Research Fellowship**
 - Designed to foster basic, translational, clinical and/or epidemiological FTD research by an outstanding scientist at an early stage of his or her career; Award Amount: \$55,000 per year for two years

- **American Heart Association Postdoctoral Research Fellowship**
 - Research broadly related to cardiovascular function and disease and stroke, or to related clinical, basic science, bioengineering or biotechnology, and public health problems, including multidisciplinary efforts; Award Amount: \$43-56,000 per year for two years plus research supply and health insurance, http://my.americanheart.org/professional/Research/FundingOpportunities/SupportingInformation/Postdoctoral-Fellowship_UCM_443314_Article.jsp
